## The Mediation Option

Reaching a consensual agreement that settles your case is far superior to a court making a decision for you, taking the matter entirely out of your hands.

A Neutral Mediator –

\*Creates an environment for settlement to occur.

\*Facilitates an agreement between the parties where the parties decide.

## Mediator Qualifications

Mediators are qualified with Basic Mediation Training of at least 30 hours minimum, Advanced Mediation Training, Annual Continuing Education, and Mediation experience. Individual courts may establish additional requirements.
